## What is Accelerated Reader?

AR is a computerized reading program designed to encourage students to read books from a variety of interests.

Participation in the AR program is not required it is voluntary.

AR works for students of all grade and ability levels.

**The program's reports give teachers** and students immediate feedback about individual reading progress and provides reinforcement in a way that is both motivational and fun.

Mrs. Reed recognizes students approximately every 4-5 weeks for reaching the goals outlined in this brochure.



## How does AR work?

1. Student chooses an AR book in the school library that is at their reading level. Teachers will help students determine their reading levels. \*ALL AR books have pink tape on the spine.



2. Student reads the book **at their own pace. If it's a picture book** it is recommended that they read the book twice.



3. Student takes a quiz about the book on the computer. Quizzes are taken in class or in the library.



## What does my score tell me?

100% means I can move my reading level up by a small amount. For example from a reading level of 2.0 to a reading level of 2.1 for my next book.

90 % or 80% stay at the same reading level of the book I just took a quiz on.

Below 80% I need to lower my reading level. For example from a 2.0 reading level to a 1.9 reading level for my next book.
